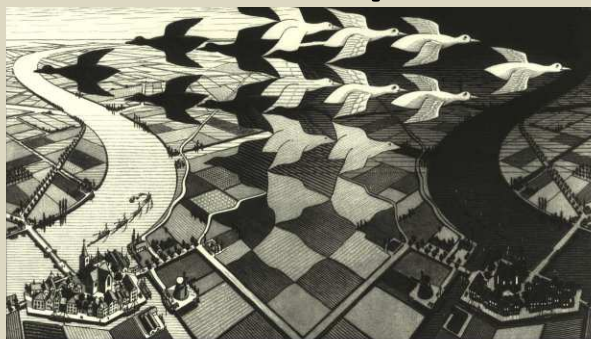

8. Deepening the knowledge of both experiences and initiatives of durable development
9. Promoting theoretical investigations and sustainable practises in Europe and Latin America that guide policy, management and planning of local development

Teaching language, period, timetable and place

Classes are held entirely in Spanish (the University of Huelva provides the possibility to take Spanish course for foreigners), from November 2010 to May 2011. Classes of theory and practice will take place Mondays and Thursdays from 5 p.m. to 9:10 p.m. in El Carmen campus. Also it is possible to follow the classes through web-based platform of the University of Huelva.
