



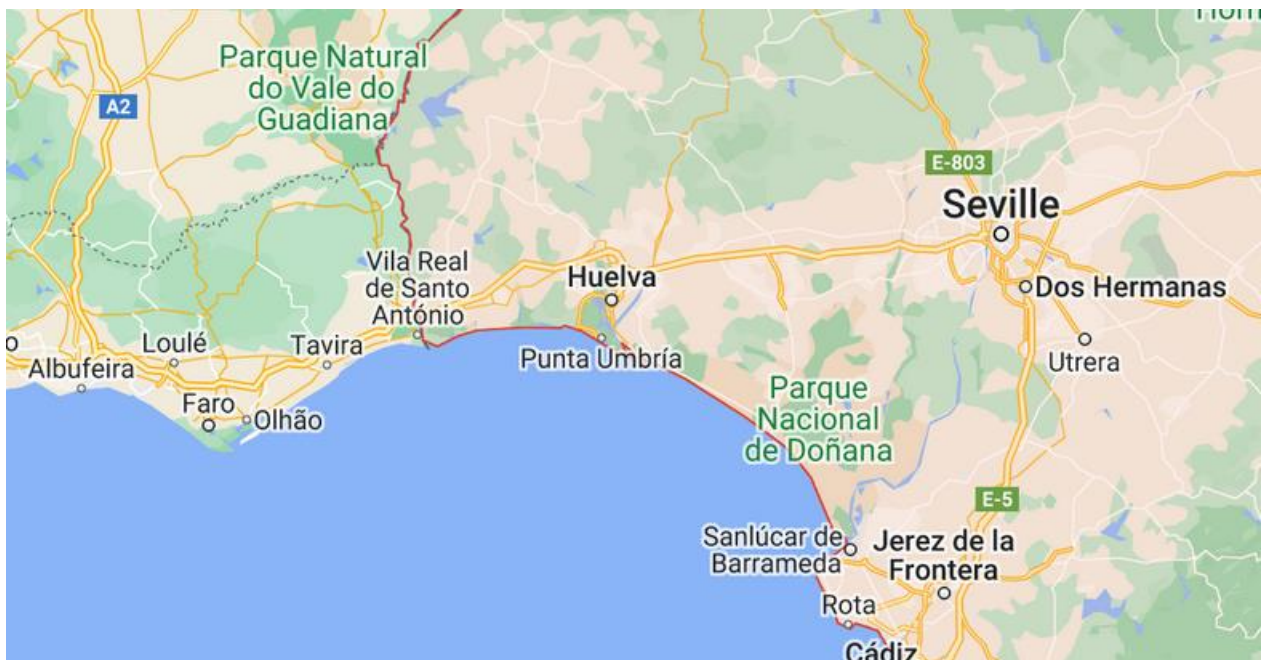

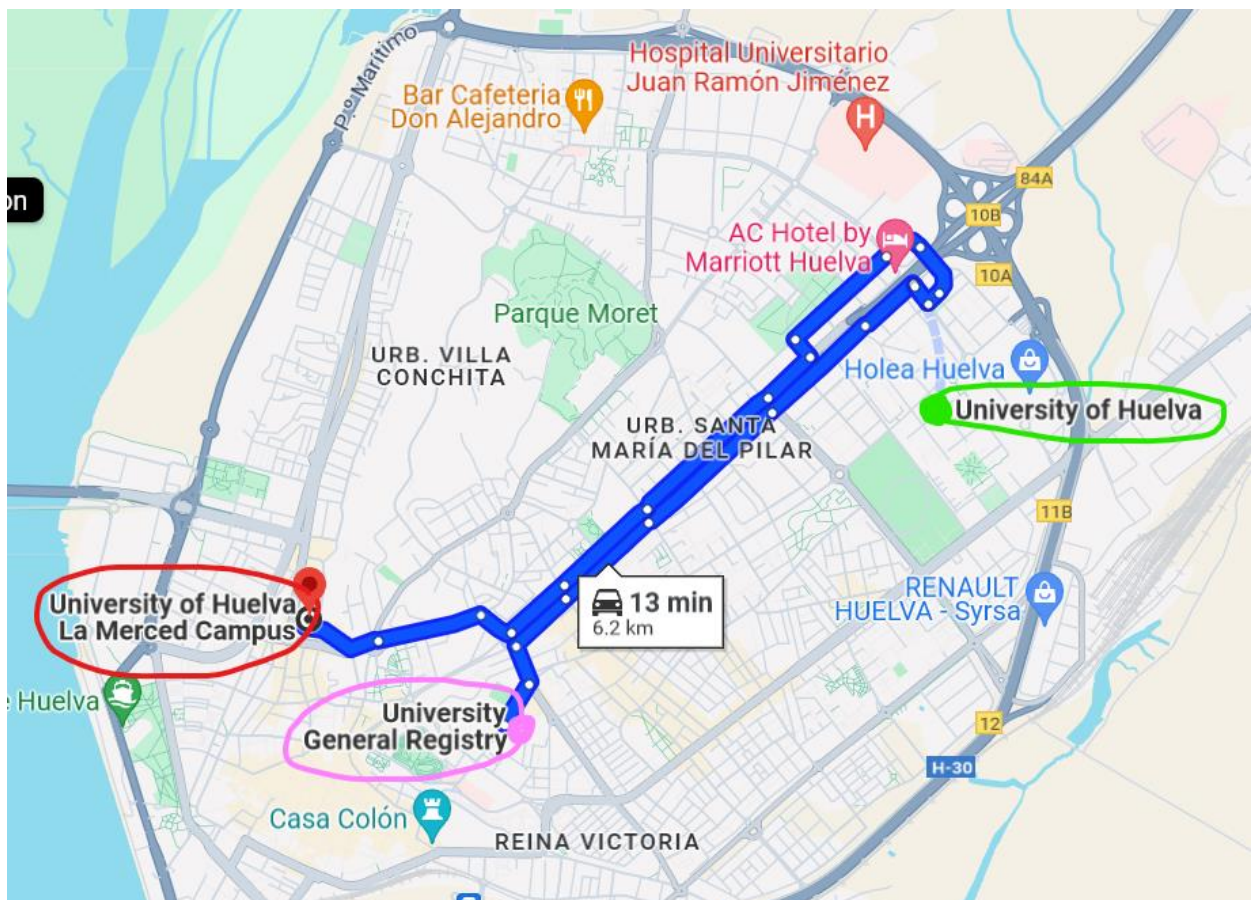
The closest airports are Faro (in Portugal) and Seville. Huelva is located between these two cities. The distance from both is more or less the same (1h 15 minutes with light traffic). Huelva does not have an airport.





The University of Huelva has three locations in Huelva:

- The Business/Tourism school in the city center (La Merced, circled in red);
- The main university campus near the outside of the city beside the outdoor shopping center (Campus el Carmen, circled in green),
- An administrative campus near the city center for administrative/financial offices (Cantero Cuadrado, circled in purple).



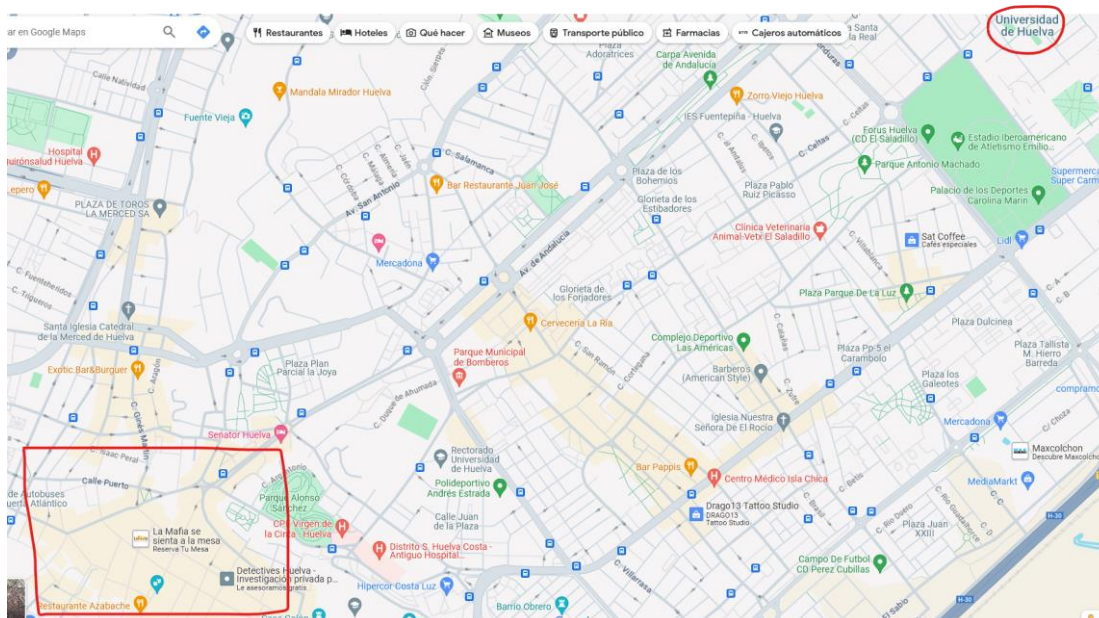
Our office is located on the Campus el Carmen (circled in green) on the main floor (planta baja) of the building Juan Agustín de Mora y Garrocho number 13, between the faculty of Humanities and the university canteen.



Most of our guests stay in the city center (in the red square), although there is one hotel near the Campus el Carmen (AC Marriott).

There are two main roads to get from the city center to the campus: Avenida de Andalucía or Avenida de las Fuerzas Armadas.

Our office is located near the entrance on Avenida de la Fuerzas Armadas. The University Campus el Carmen (the red circle) is 2,7km from the city center, between 30-40 minutes on foot, 15-20 minutes by bus, or 7-10 minutes in the car.



Getting to Huelva from other cities:

Most of our guests travel from Faro, Seville, Malaga, or Madrid.

Keep in mind that if you are travelling in a group, even a small one, it is still worthwhile to check prices and options in Huelva Transfer:

Since Huelva does not have an airport, guests will need to come by car, train, or bus.





From Seville (Spain)


<p>BUS</p>	<p>Check which bus station you are arriving to/departing from as there are two main bus stations in Seville. To get to Huelva from Sevilla, you need to leave from the bus station Plaza de Armas. If you are getting to the Seville airport, you will need to get a taxi or a bus to the Plaza de Armas bus station. The bus company in Seville is Damas. If the bus to Huelva goes on the A49 motorway, the trip should take around 1h 15 minutes. There is a panel to check which motorway your bus will be taking, to ensure you are going on the A49, which is the fastest option. <p>TREN</p>	<p>The train station in Seville is Santa Justa. Renfe is the Company that manages all the trains. Faro (Portugal)

AUTOBUS	<p>If you are travelling to Faro in Portugal, you can check the times and prices here: https://www.flixbus.es/rutas/faro-huelva</p> <p>The Price for a one-way ticket is around 16€, or 27€ for roundtrip. The buses between Faro and Huelva are not frequent so please check that you will be able to get from Faro to Huelva before flying into Faro.</p>  <p>The screenshot shows the FlixBus website interface. Malaga (Spain)

TREN	<p>There are no direct trains from Malaga to Huelva. You will have to change trains in Sevilla. AUTOBUS	Alsabus manages the buses from Malaga to Seville, but then you will have to do another search for Sevilla to Huelva since there are no direct buses.

Madrid (Spain)

AUTOBUS	<p>The cheapest way to get to Huelva from Madrid is by bus. The Company that manages the buses to Huelva is Socibus. It takes around 7 hours by bus and costs around 35€ for a one-way ticket. There is an option of a night bus that leaves around midnight.</p> <p>See prices and times: https://socibusventas.es/en/</p>
TREN	<p>The more comfortable option to get to Huelva from Madrid is in train. The Atocha train station is located in the very city center of Madrid, and there is only one train station in Huelva. There is a direct train every day that takes around 4 hours, and multiple trains Madrid to Seville. There are different types of trains. The fastest train is the AVE (high velocity train). The train that takes 4 hours is ALVIA.</p> <p>To check schedules and prices check Renfe: www.renfe.com/es/en</p>
