here me?



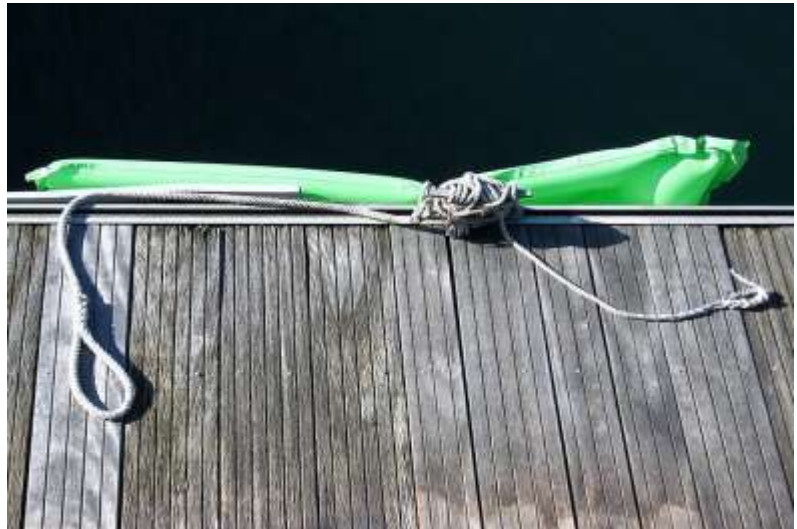
