Description

This module covers the most important aspects of Land-Planning in Spain, and some Laws which affect the design of Land-Use Plans.

The approach taken is to know the structure and contents of Land-Use Plans since the analysis of this kind of documents.

The module is divided into three interconnected sections: (I) Notion, philosophy and methods of Land-Planning; (II) Land-Planning in different territorial levels; and (III) Process of specific topics and areas in Land-Use Plans.

Aims

The aim of this module is to provide the student with:

A critical understanding of the theoretical, conceptual and methodological options available for Land-Planning design, and analyses;

Skills to design, analyse and produce specific components of Land-Use Plans.

An advanced level of knowledge of current Land-Planning in Spain.

Appreciate the need of sustainability criteria for the redaction of Land-Use Plans.

Analyze and evaluate Land-Use Plans.

Write specific parts of a Land-Use Plan, related with environment.

Articulate a knowledge of current Land-Planning policies in Spain.

Critically engage with territorial policies.
