Professor of Economics at University of Huelva. Research fellow in the Erasmus School of Economics (Erasmus Universiteit Rotterdam, NH). PhD in Economics in 2001. PhD Program Coordinator (Economics, Finance and Computer Science, University of Huelva and International University of Andalusia). Program Director of the Master in Big Data, International University of Andalusia.

He was also Director of the MSc in Economics, Finance and Computer Science (2015-2018) and the MSc in Quantitative Economic Analysis (Fundación CentRA & University of Huelva, 2004). He was the Head of the Spanish Entrepreneurship Research Group (2007-2019) and the coordinator of the Regional Economics Research Group at the Fundación Centro de



Estudios Andaluces (2003-2005). He has previously been Head of Economics and Director of Academic Affairs.

Most of his research has been published in indexed academic journals (Small Business Economics, Tourism Management, Journal of Business Venturing, International Small Business Journal, Industry and Trade, Empirical Economics, Journal of Policy Modeling, Economic Modelling, Energy Policy, among others) and some chapters and books in reputed international Publishers (Springer, Edward Elgar, Emerald).

During the last ten years, he has published 42 pieces of research in recorded by WoS, 33 of them in journals with JCR into two main areas: the economics of self-employment and entrepreneurship and works of applied economics. Some of his works have had a high impact in the field. In particular, 6 papers on self-employment have gained more than 40 citations. He has 32 articles with 644 citations and h-index of 15 in the Web of Science.

His current research focuses on stability of the New Keynesian hybrid Phillips curve, on optimal public deficit and tax-smoothing, and on explosive behaviour in public debt and the long-run fiscal sustainability.

Finally, he currently leads two projects of research devoted to analyze the new trends in the labour market in the post-covid19 Era and a project of technology transfer oriented to build statistical indicators for monitoring the digital sector.
