## Part B. CV SUMMARY (max. 5000 characters, including spaces)

Luis Eguren is catedrático de lengua española at the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid since 2008. He has been awarded five “sexenios de investigación”, and his research has mainly focused on Spanish syntax and grammatical theory.

His work on Spanish syntax, which incorporates current developments of formal grammar and consistently deals with inter and cross-linguistic variation phenomena, centers on the nominal and adjectival domains. In these studies, he analyses the distributional and interpretive properties of personal pronouns, possessives, noun ellipsis, nominal and adjectival constructions with measure phrases, adjectival degree wh-phrases, and determiners and quantifiers like *otro*, *cierto*, *distinto* or *algún que otro*, among other topics. The results of these investigations have been presented at international conferences and workshops (*Going Romance, Linguistic Symposium on Romance Languages, Hispanic Linguistic Symposium, Annual Meeting of the Berkeley Linguistics Society, Annual Meeting of the Societas Linguistica Europaea, Annual Conference of the Germanic Linguistics Society, Colloquium on Generative Grammar, International Contrastive Linguistics Conference...*), and have appeared either as contributions in volumes edited by highly-ranked publishers, such as John Benjamins, Blackwell or Routledge, or as articles in well-known journals (*Natural Language and Linguistic Theory, Lingua, Probus, Studia Lingüística, Revue Romane, Studies in Hispanic and Lusophone Linguistics, Revista de Lingüística Teórica y Aplicada, Revista Internacional de Lingüística Iberoamericana, Revista Española de Lingüística, Verba, Lingüística Española Actual*).

As for his research on grammatical theory, he has studied both the evolution of chomskyan linguistics and the foundations of the Parametric Theory of Syntactic Variation. The results of this line of research include the book *Introducción a una sintaxis minimalista* (Madrid, Gredos, 2004), written in collaboration with Olga Fernández Soriano, his papers and talks on the content of Universal Grammar, and two critical reviews of Parameters Theory: “Parametric syntax: an overview”, published as part of a volume edited by Cambridge Scholar Publishing, and the introduction to *Rethinking Parameters* (Oxford, Oxford University Press, 2016).

Luis Eguren has been principal investigator in three funded research projects (“Gramática formal y variación sintáctica”, “La variación en las interfaces sintaxis-componentes interpretativos” y “Microparámetros en las interficies de la sintaxis con otros componentes del sistema lingüístico. Variación gramatical y variedades del español”), and has participated in two “acciones complementarias” that supported the organization of the *XVIth Colloquium on Generative Grammar* (Madrid, 2006) and the *Workshop on Formal Grammar and Syntactic Variation* (Madrid, 2011). These events resulted in the publication of two books, which contained a selection of the papers presented at these two meetings: *Coreference, Modality and Focus. Studies at the Syntax-Semantics Interface* (Amsterdam, John Benjamins, 2007), coedited with Olga Fernández Soriano, and *Rethinking Parameters*, which was edited with the additional collaboration of Amaya Mendikoetxea.

He has also been a visiting scholar at the Department of Linguistics in MIT (fall 2008) and at the Department of Theoretical and Applied Linguistics of the University of Cambridge, UK (fall 2018), under the financial support of two grants from the “Plan de Ayudas para el profesorado universitario”.

Moreover, he has supervised two Ph.D. dissertations and a good number of M.A thesis and has been an ANEP evaluator of research projects, postdoctoral grants, and stays at foreign universities. His professional service also includes book chapters reviewing for John Benjamins, Blackwell and Routledge, article reviewing for *Lingua, Syntax* and *Studia Linguistica*, among other journals, the organization of conferences and workshops, and conference abstract reviewing.
