PhD in Psychology from the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid (UAM), Clinical Psychologist recognized by the Ministry of Education and Science and Psychologist Specialist in Psychotherapy recognized by the European Federation of Psychologists' Associations. Professor of the area of Personality, Evaluation and Psychological Treatments at the Faculty of Psychology of the UAM and coordinator of three subjects of the Bachelor's degree in Psychology. Likewise, she was the director of the PhD Program in Behavioral Science at the UAM from 2001 until its extinction in 2015. Actually, she is the director of the Master in Analisis de la Conducta at the UAM. Her research career has covered various areas (addictions, health psychology, domestic violence...). During the last fifteen years, it has been focused on the analysis of the verbal interaction between therapist and client, aiming at the identification of the learning processes involved in the clinical change. Future research lines are now focused on the development of an observational methodology that allows for the determination of the most effective intervention strategies, as well as the study of the behavior of the therapists who carry out such strategies, thus combining both process and outcome research. She is the director of the ACOVEO group (Analysis of verbal behavior in clinical contexts with observational methodology), formed by professors from different universities and specialists in clinical psychology, and whose main goal is to study the processes that explain therapeutic change through the analysis of verbal interaction



in clinical settings. She has directed the projects "Analysis of variables associated with behavioral change in clinical contexts: study of verbal behavior in the therapeutic process" (I+D 2007), "Functional study of the verbal interaction between therapist and client during the therapeutic process" (I+D 2010), and "Functional study of clinical interaction in patients with a diagnosis of mental illness" (I+D 2016). She has carried out research stays at the Center for Studies and Research in Behavior of the University of Guadalajara (Mexico). She has numerous contributions to both national and international congresses, she has authored several books and book chapters and she has published more than one hundred research papers in renowned national and international peer-reviewed journals. She has carried out review activities for more than ten specialized journals and she is a member of the editorial committee of three important journals in her area of study. Among the various invited lectures given throughout her academic career, the one entitled Why Do Psychological Treatments Work?, given during the 6th International Conference of the Association for Behavior Analysis (ABA) (2011, Granada) stands out for its special relevance. In the last ten years she has directed 8 doctoral theses on the observational study of the verbal interaction in the field of clinical psychology. In 2010 she was awarded, along with other members of her team, the Rafael Burgaleta Psychology award for her study "An Approach to the Functional Study of the Verbal Interaction Between Therapist and Client During the Therapeutic Process". She has been an external evaluator for ANEP from 2006 to 2017, with a total of 18 projects evaluated in the areas of Clinical and Health Psychology.
