

## THE *AMORES* OF OVID IN THE *FRAGMENTUM TREVIRENSE*

In 1995 we were the first to offer information<sup>1</sup> on the complete contents of the *Fragmentum Trevirens*e, which had been previously used in the editions of *Tristia* by, among others, S. G. Owen, R. Ehwald, G. Luck, J. André, J. B. Hall and G. P. Goold<sup>2</sup>. The contents referring to the *Metamorphoses* and the *Amores*, however, had previously received no attention.

The so-called *Fragmentum Trevirens*e is composed, in fact, of six sections: I: *Metamorphoses*, 5.574-6.55; II: *Metamorphoses*, 7.292-451; III: *Metamorphoses*, 7.218-93, 456-539, 709-88 and 8.414-93; IV: *Metamorphoses*, 10.96-183, 551-93, 596-638; V: *Amores*, 3.3.12-48; 3.4.1-48; 3.6.1-10; and VI: *Tristia*, 1.11.1-31; 1.11.33-2.21; 4.4.35-65; 4.4.67-4.5.9.

The lines of the *Metamorphoses* contained in sections I-IV of the *Fragmentum Trevirens*e were collated by F. Navarro and E. Baeza in 1999<sup>3</sup>. Section VI, covering the *Tristia*, has been newly collated and published by E. Baeza<sup>4</sup>.

The remaining task is therefore the collation of section V, which contains some lines from Ovid's *Amores* and is the subject of the present study. These verses are preserved on a single, small folio, with annotations on a variety of topics in the margins and above the lines. The majority feature explanations of proper names, as in 3.3.17 *Cephesia] andromeda casiope filia*, or glosses to aid the comprehension of certain terms, as in 3.3.20 *inulta] sine ultione* and 3.3.35 *iaculatur] fulminatur*, or clarifications to help the reader follow the storyline, as in 3.3.22 *deceptus] ego* and 3.3.26 *solas] puellas*. In the critical *apparatus* we include only those annotations which offer readings of possible critical interest. The additions included in the margins are along the same lines. Most are illegible owing to the faded ink, or else to cuts, folds or the inevitable holes. The numbers are an approximate indication of the lines to which the notes in the margin refer. They do not contribute different readings to the text of the *Amores*, but simply represent unrefined attempts to explain or interpret the contents of the verses. Here are some examples: 3.3.17 *indigne petra dolorum*; 3.3.34 *puelle que non sunt adeo fortes (...) deos decipiunt sine periuria* and 3.4.19 (...) *nullo modo potuit seruari et hic (...) argus, custos iunonis, cum io concubuit*.

The folio is distributed as follows:  $f^r = 3.3.12\text{--}3.4.8$  (with lines 9-12 missing);  $f^v = 3.4.13\text{--}3.6.10$  (as in many manuscripts, the dream elegy, 3.5, is not included). The manuscript can be dated to the 12<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> centuries given that its readings coincide with those of the *recentiores*, as can be observed in the critical *apparatus* presented below. To date, its readings have only been included in the recently published *Bibliotheca Teubneriana* edition<sup>5</sup>.

We now offer the first edition with critical apparatus of the section containing the *Amores* of Ovid. We follow the sigla of the Teubner edition by A. Ramírez de Verger. In the *apparatus* we

begin in each case with the reading offered by the *Fragmentum Trevirens*.
